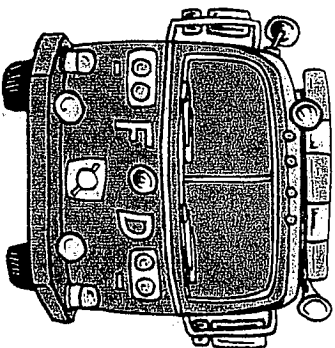

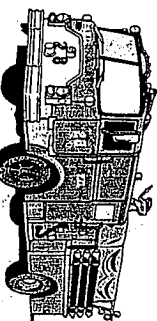

The following are the Rules and Regulations of the Fireman's Tournament. This event will be open to everyone — Five Member Teams. Anything not completely listed within these rules shall be covered by the Rules and Regulations of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC).

The responsibility of complying with these Rules and Regulations lies equally with each individual as well as the team captain. It is everyone's duty to make sure the averages listed on the face of this entry are 100% correct. Inaccurate averages are basis for disqualification.

1. The Fireman's Tournament will bowl on Friday, Saturday and Sunday on the dates and times indicated on the face of this entry. Entries close prior to 1st squad.
2. Lanes 1 to 24 will be covered by sanction. Squad sizes will be determined by lane availability at that time. A minimum of 10 teams must bowl at the same time, or squad will be cancelled and entries will be rescheduled. No entry fees will be refunded under any circumstances — once tournament has begun.
3. Multiple entries will be allowed. Not more than three players on the same team can cash more than once in the prize list. Prizes awarded on a basis of 1:8 entries in the team event. Prize fee returned 100%.
4. In a Regular Sanctioned Tournament, all entrants must be members of USBC. Non-members can qualify for entry by paying an associate membership fee of \$21 or pay a \$5 participation fee. (Rule 300c).
5. Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned league ending book average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2010-2011 season. If current game average for 21 games or more as of March 15, 2012, is 10 or more pins above 2010-2011 ending book average, then current average must be used. If no 2010-2011 average, use highest current USBC sanctioned average, 21 or more games as of March 15, 2012. All other men will use a 200 scratch average and women will use a 160 scratch average.
6. Handicap will be based on 80% of the difference between the team's entering average and a team's scratch score of 1150.
7. Averages of all winning teams will be carefully checked. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the end of the tournament.
8. All bowlers must comply with USBC Rule 319e concerning AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT. Any bowler who has been rerated for any reason must submit this fact in writing for entry into this tournament. Failure to comply with this rule may result in forfeiture of all entry fees and/or prize winnings.
9. Any bowler who has won \$600 or more during the past 12 months must comply with USBC Rule 319d.
10. No present or past PBA/LPBT member or anyone else deemed professional by the Tournament Director will be allowed to participate in this tournament. The Tournament Director has the sole authority to accept or reject any team entry into this tournament, for any reason.
11. Unmarried grade or high school students 18 years of age and under must have parental approval in writing for entry in this tournament. It must be received at least one week prior to participation unless the student is accompanied by his/her parent or legal guardian in which case the parental consent form may be filed up to the time the student starts to bowl. Failure to comply with this is cause for disqualification.
12. All checks should be made payable to CAPITAL DISTRICT VOLUNTEER FIREMAN'S TOURNAMENT. Any personal checks returned to our bank for any reason will be cause for automatic disqualification.
13. Team captains must report to tournament headquarters 30 minutes prior to squad time.
14. In order to expedite team check-in, all lanes will be assigned by the Tournament Director, as he sees fit.
15. In all cases where these rules do not apply, USBC rules will be in effect.
16. Once you mail or drop off your entry blank and do not hear from the tournament director in 10 days consider your first choice of time and date confirmed.
17. For each shift, the team which has the highest total scratch and the highest total with handicap will receive \$25 each. The individual who has the high game scratch and the high triple scratch for the tournament will also receive \$25 each.
